ending to a fast school year. I am so proud of our teachers making sure the children are getting what they need before the end of the school year. Our

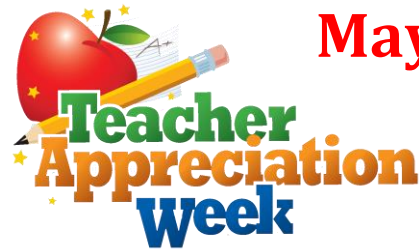
