We are thankful for November! Thanksgiving crafts are coming soon.

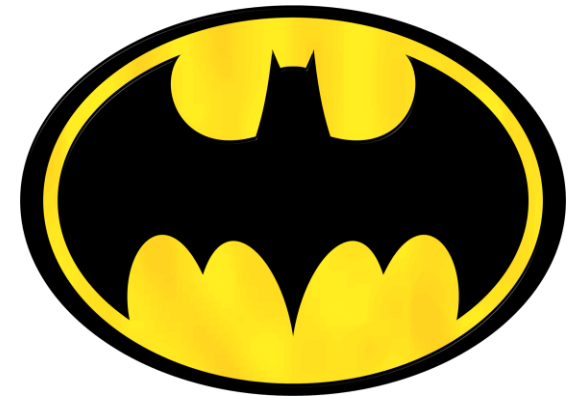
