October is Farm Month. We will be talking about farm animals all month. Next week we will be reading the Little Red Hen. We will also be talking about chickens and homemade bread. Here is a recipe for easy homemade bread.

Homemade Bread

Bake bread just like the Little Red Hen did! Your child can help to stir together the ingredients for this easy-to-make batter bread.

1 envelope yeast; 2 Tsp. salt
1 $\frac{1}{4}$ cups very warm water
2 Tbsp butter, melted
2 Tbsp. sugar
2 Cups all-purpose flour
1 cup whole wheat flour



Dissolve yeast, sugar, and salt in very warm water. Add butter and stir. Stir in half the flour. Beat well with a wooden spoon. Slowly stir in remaining flour, beating well. Cover with a damp towel and set in a warm place to rise until it doubles in size, about half an hour. Stir the batter down. Grease a 9"x5" loaf pan. Spread the dough evenly in pan. Cover with a damp towel and let rise again until it is about an inch below the top of the pan. Bake at 350 degrees about 45 minutes or until brown. Cool on a rack. ENJOY!
